

QUESTION #3 Correct Answer: C

Rationales:

- A) Objects of the College relate to regulation of the profession of Respiratory Therapy of governance of individual members. The CRTO does not have jurisdiction over administrative employment standards.
- B) The CRTO does not pass regulations into law. Any regulations drafted by the CRTO must receive government approval prior to becoming law.
- C) "To develop, establish and maintain programs to assist individuals to exercise their rights under this Code and the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991" is listed as object #6 under section 3(1) of the Health Professions Procedural Code. Such programs would include processes for handling patient/client complaints.
