

**QUESTION #4 Correct Answer: C**

**Rationales:**

- A) This is not required in a situation where the diagnostic procedure is being used to determine if there is an emergency.
- B) This is not necessary as the RT can undertake this procedure under emergency circumstances.
- C) No consent is required as this diagnostic procedure is required to determine the existence of an emergency and reasonable efforts have been made to obtain consent.
