

Background

The College of Respiratory Therapists of Ontario's (CRTO) Accessibility Standards policy was first approved by Council on April 30, 2012 and last revised in August 2018. As part of our policy framework this policy was reviewed and updated.

The purpose of the Accessibility Standards policy is to identify access barriers, improve opportunities and provide accessibility for people with disabilities. The CRTO is committed to serving all its stakeholders with a professionally recognized disability and to meet accessibility requirements in CRTO dealings under the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA)*.
