

Background

This policy has been revised and updated into a new Professional Practice Policy to align with the CRTO's Policy Framework. This new category of policies will help provide a strong framework to enhance the understanding of the role that Respiratory Therapists (RTs) hold to ensure public/patient safety in the use of narcotics in the healthcare environment.

This information previously existed as a Position Statement, created July 2014. This document has been converted into a new Professional Practice Policy. Professional Practice Policies set out expectations and responsibilities for Members beyond what is outlined in the Standards of Practice.
