

Supervision Policy

Consultation Summary

Background

The CRTC Council last approved the Supervision Policy in May 2022. Since then, the College has reviewed and updated the policy to reflect a broader range of supervision requirements. These changes respond to the new currency condition, the increasing number of internationally educated applicants, and the use of terms, conditions and limitations on General certificates.

The revised policy went through a detailed review process, including an external legal review.

Consultation Feedback Details

The draft revised policy was posted on the CRTC's consultations webpage and shared through the CRTC's social media channels. In total, 79 people viewed the consultation survey and 5 respondents completed it.

(Views vs. Completions)

Respondents generally supported the proposed revisions. Based on the feedback received, the CRTC added the following clarification regarding the appropriate degree of supervision:

A supervisor may determine that a higher degree of supervision is appropriate than the minimum level required by the CRTC. For example, a supervisor may require an RT who is registered with a general supervision condition to work under direct supervision for the first two weeks of employment. In these situations, the RT must follow the supervision requirements set by the supervisor. However, supervision requirements set by a supervisor cannot be less restrictive than those imposed by the CRTC. For example, a supervisor cannot permit an RT who is registered with direct supervision to practise under general supervision.

Outcome

Council reviewed and approved the final policy and consultation feedback at its June 26, 2026 meeting.



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
