ORDERING CHEST X-RAYS

QUESTION

Can an RRT order a chest x-ray?

ANSWER

RRTs do not have the authority to order tests or procedures. However, an RRT can implement a physicianauthorized medical directive for a chest x-ray order – provided respiratory therapists are listed in the directive as an implementer or co-implemeter. A properly constructed medical directive should stipulate the specific patient/client conditions that must be met before the chest x-ray is ordered, as well as any additional certification or education the implementer must have (e.g., completion of a organizational training program).
