QUESTION

The general surgeons at our organization want the RRTs to become certified to remove chest tubes. Are RTs permitted to perform this procedure?

ANSWER

Yes. *Chest tube insertion, aspiration, reposition and removal* is an <u>Advance Prescribed Procedure Below the</u> <u>Dermis</u> that is authorized to Registered Respiratory Therapists. However, prior to performing this procedure, the RRTs at your organization are required to complete a CRTO-approved certification program.

Please note that Graduate and Limited (Practical) RTs are not permitted to perform any advanced prescribed procedures below the dermis.
