

Proposed Legislation Regarding Interjurisdictional Mobility

On February 21, 2023, the Ontario government introduced [Bill 60 – Your Health Act, 2023](#). If passed, this will allow Respiratory Therapists already registered in another Canadian jurisdiction to practice for a period of time in Ontario without being registered with the CRTO. That “period of time” is yet to be determined.

The CRTO continues to make every effort to register all applicants as quickly as possible, while at the same time ensuring that the public of Ontario receives high-quality, safe, competent and ethical care from Registered Respiratory Therapists (RRTs).

The CRTO supports all efforts to ensure there is a sufficient number of practitioners to deliver the essential services that RRTs provide, and that this care is provided by qualified and competent RRTs.
